



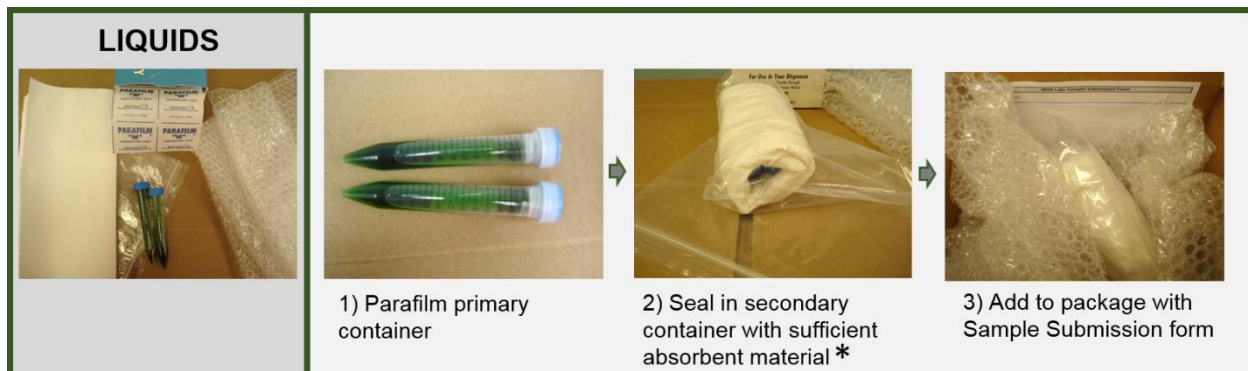
Submit-a-sample checklist:

- 1. Complete Sample Submission Form online, print and enclose.
 - **For mixed culture specify:**
 - Isolate all colony types and ID each
 - Isolate predominant colony type and ID
 - ID a particular colony (circle on plate)

- 2. Prepare samples for shipping per **MIDI Labs USDA/APHIS PPQ 526 Permit to Receive Unknown Biological Agents:**
 - Plates
 - Parafilm plate(s) -or- tape plate(s) and seal in zip-top bag
 - Then, seal in zip-top bag



- Liquids
 - Parafilm cap of tube(s) -or- tape cap of tube(s) and seal in zip-top
 - Then, seal in zip-top bag **with sufficient absorbent material** to absorb entire contents



*Absorbent materials included paper towels, cellulose wadding, and benchtop absorbent pads.



- Powders
 - Seal sample in Whirl-Pak -or- zip-top bag
 - Then, seal in second zip-top bag



- **3.** Place sample(s) and submission form in a box and ship using Priority Overnight service. For Same Day turnaround time, you must specify 8am delivery (e.g., FedEx First Overnight or UPS Early A.M).

- “Saturday Delivery” accepted from 9am – 1pm, must specify Saturday Delivery on shipping document. Priority overnight sent on a Friday will not be delivered until Monday.
- Shipping suggestion: Although it’s not necessary to ship your samples at refrigeration temperature, during warmer weather place an ice pack or two in your sample box to prevent “media meltdown”.
